Y2 Design Technology – MTP Textiles Unit – Spring Term

Ladders for the Unit:

<p>Lesson 1</p>	<p><u>LI: Y2T-M3 I can thread a needle.</u></p> <p><u>LI: Y2T-M4 I can sew a running stitch (evenly) to join fabrics.</u></p> <p>Stick in Knowledge catcher and answer question.</p> <p>Stick in Lesson 1 LIs sheet – there is space for photo evidence of children sewing a running stitch and for there piece of felt with running stitch to be stuck in.</p> <p>Model how to thread a needle and tie a knot.</p> <p>Watch the video on how to do a running stitch. https://www.kapowprimary.com/subjects/design-technology/key-stage-1/year-2/textiles-pouches/lesson-1-running-stitch/)Pupil Running Stitch) - Play this on loop while the children have a go.</p> <p>Questions to ask; What is this called? (A needle). How do I thread it? What can I do if I have trouble? Which direction am I sewing in? 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<p>Lesson 2</p>	<p>What must I remember to do?</p> <p><u>LI: Y2T-M5 I can pin and neatly cut fabric using a template.</u></p> <p><u>LI: Y2T-M1 I can select and cut fabrics for sewing.</u></p> <p><u>LI: Y2T-D1 I can design a pouch.</u></p> <p>Stick in Lesson 2 Lis sheet. There is space for the children to stick their templates on after they have used them to cut round their fabric with.</p> <p>Plan</p> <p>Hand out the Activity: Pouch templates to each of the children and ask them to draw on the templates where their stitches will go (in a square U-shape around the bottom).</p> <p>The children should then cut out their templates and put their names on the back.</p> <p>Make</p> <p>The children secure their cut out templates to their felt using pins.</p> <p>The children use scissors, ideally fabric ones, to cut around the template.</p> <p>Questions to ask; Which sides will be sewn together? Which parts will be open? What will this piece of fabric do? What do we need to consider when we sew?</p>	<p>Resources</p>	<p>Key vocab</p> <p>fabric</p> <p>knot</p>
<p>Lesson 3</p>	<p><u>LI: Y2T-M4 I can sew a running stitch (evenly) to join fabrics.</u></p> <p><u>LI: Y2T-D1 I can design a pouch.</u></p> <p>Stick in Lesson 3 sheet (pouch design).</p> <p>Lesson delivery:</p> <p>Make</p> <p>Children to choose the colour of their thread.</p> <p>Pin the two pieces of fabric together, ensuring that the edges line up.</p>	<p>Resources</p>	<p>Key vocab</p> <p>fabric</p> <p>knot</p> <p>needle</p> <p>needle threader</p> <p>running stitch</p> <p>sew</p>



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	<p>Watch the Pupil Video: Making a Pouch – watch till 1.28. https://www.kapowprimary.com/subjects/design-technology/key-stage-1/year-2/textiles-pouches/lesson-3-making-a-pouch/</p> <p>Children to sew the three sides of their pouches together, making sure they leave the top flap open!</p> <p>Design</p> <p>Children to create two designs on how they might decorate their pouch, using the template.</p> <p>Tell children what they have available and give each child a copy of the Activity: Front of pouch design sheet to draw different design ideas for the front of their pouch.</p> <p>*Children can cut out bits of felt and glue these on/ sequins/ glitter glue?*</p>		thread
Lesson 4	<p><u>LI: Y2T-M2 I can decorate a pouch using fabric glue or attempt a running stitch.</u> <u>LI: Y2T-E1 I can solve simple, age-appropriate problems (teacher posed).</u></p> <p>Stick in lesson 4 sheet – There is space on this sheet for photo evidence of the children’s pouch and evaluation questions.</p> <p>Make</p> <p>Give children time to look at both of their designs. Tell them to pick one as their final design and they will use this to create their design on their pouch.</p> <p>Once they have collected the necessary resources, the children should cut and glue as required to decorate their pouch.</p> <p>Complete the evaluation questions. Did your final product match your design? Is your product functional? What would you do differently if you made it again?</p>	Resources	Key vocab decorate fabric glue
