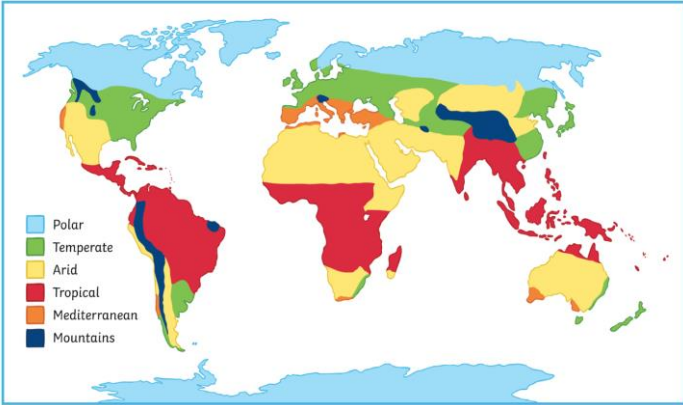
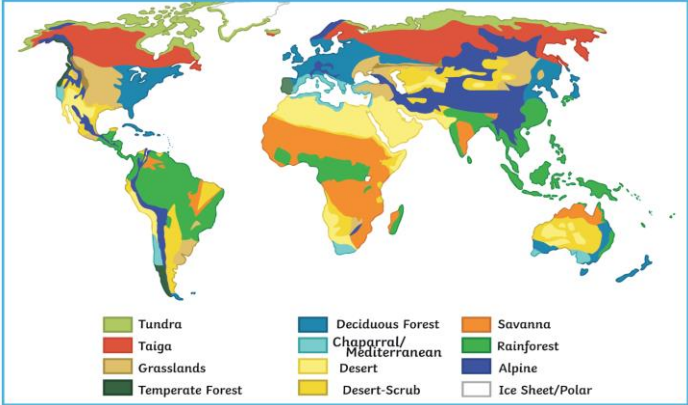


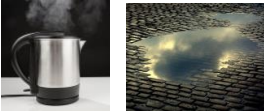

Key Vocabulary	
weather	The way the air feels. It is the outside temperature, strength of the wind, and whether it is raining, sunny, hailing, snowing, sleeting, foggy, or cloudy. 
climate	The long term pattern of weather in an area over a long period of time.
biomes	Areas of the planet with similar climates, landscapes, animals and plants.
Greenland	An island country that is part of Denmark, located between the Arctic and Atlantic oceans.
Ilulissat	The largest town in Greenland.
thermometer	An instrument for measuring temperature. 
water cycle	The continuous journey water takes from the sea, to the sky, to the land and back to the sea.
evaporation	Turning a liquid into a gas. 
condensation	Turning a gas into a liquid. 
precipitation	Liquid or solid particles that fall from a cloud as rain, sleet, hail or snow.
