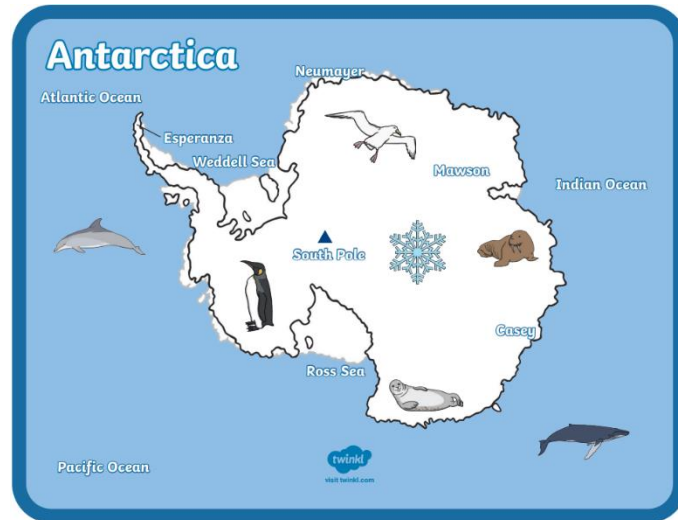


Winter Wonderland - Antarctica

iceberg	Ice that has broken off a glacier and is floating in open water.

Locational Knowledge

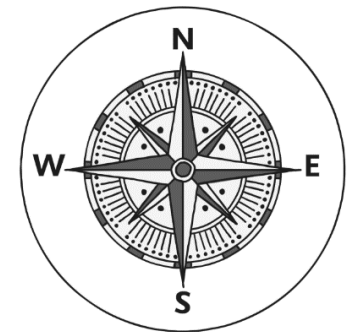
- Antarctica is a continent.
