- Guide and encourage players to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance
- Respect and uphold the laws/rules of the game
- Discourage actions and behaviour contrary to the spirit of the BPSSA

Code of Conduct for school pupils/players

- Treat a match/performance as a game that is fun
- Play to the rules of the sport
- Encourage others to do their best
- Enjoy participating
- Accept all decisions by match officials
- Recognise good performances by others, including opponents
- Accept victory modestly
- Learn to take defeat in the right manner
- Shake hands with your opponent at the end of the game regardless of the result.

Code of Conduct for all school parents/supporters

- Respect all decisions made by match officials
- Be a good role model by positively supporting teams/performances in every way
- Respect all other spectators, staff and participants
- Recognise and respect the performances of opposition schools
- Accept victory modestly and defeat graciously
- Stand/sit in the place you have been allocated during the event
- Do not interfere with instructions given by school staff or competition officials
