

Year 1. Unit 1:6 Animated Stories

In this unit, children are introduced to electronic books (e-books). First, pupils look at an example of an e-book and discuss similarities and differences between traditional books and e-books. They use '2Create a Story' to create their own animated story, and begin by using drawing tools available on the App in 'My Simple Mode' to draw their character. They draw upon knowledge of available drawing tools that they gained when previously using 'Paint Projects' (in Unit 1.1 Online Safety and Introduction to Purple Mash and Unit 1.4 Lego Builders), and knowledge of how to use the mouse to create digital artwork. They add text to their e-books, building and developing upon their knowledge gained initially in the Introduction Unit (but also developed through Unit 1:1 and more indiscreetly by subsequent units) where by children learnt how to enter text into their work (using capital letters, using the backspace key, using the space bar, adding full stops). New knowledge is gained by children as they learn how to animate their digital pictures by adding their choice of movement from a wide variety of available options, and through adding sound effects – either selected from a sound category, or by recording their own tune on the app. Pupils are then introduced to the advanced mode in 2Create a story where they learn how to add backgrounds; can make use of additional drawing tools when drawing their objects; and can change the font style and size. At the end of each lesson, children are required to save their e-books so that they can load them the following week to continue working on them. They are reminded of how to save and load their work in each lesson and are reminded of the terms 'file' 'overwrite' and 'My Work folder'. By the end of the unit, children will have created at least one animated story.
